1. President's report

The Rotary year 2018/2019 was a most exciting one for our club. New members joined and we engaged in many events which raised thousands of crowns for charity. The highlight was once again the annual Dragon Boat Race which took place in May 2019 raising unprecedented sums for charity. We also continued to raise funds for our WASH project in India though a very successful "Indian Food Helps" campaign in November. Members of the club visited Rajasthan in 2019 and distributed the funds to the schools. For the third year running RCPI has been flipping burgers for charity at the Prague Burgerfest. The weather was great and the RCPI volunteers worked hard making and selling our very own Dragon Burgers with the secret chilli sauce provided by Mamun. One customer, who was a restaurant owner, was so impressed with our burger that he asked for the recipe. In October we also held the The Sananim Anniversary Gala at the Intercontinental Hotel in Prague yesterday evening, organised by Naomi Sullivan Callender and her able team. Jiri Richter, CEO of Sananim, thanked everyone for attending and explained the work of the charity and how important funding from donors is to the operation of the charity.. The event raised substantial funding for the Sananim Charity which makes such a tremendous difference to the lives of those with drug addiction.

The youth exchange programme brought exchange students to Prague to experience life in the Czech republic.

We also continued with social events such as a very interesting visit combined with diner to the Barrandov studios in Prague and the exchange visit to the UK where club members met up with members of our partner club, Bristol Breakfast Rotary.

October was a proud moment for RC Prague International: We were awarded the Number One Club in District 2240 for making the highest per capita contribution to the Rotary Foundation 2017/18. Thank you to all who made this possible and in doing so helped the Rotary Foundation in transforming lives for the better throughout the world.

A great year of events, fundraising and a great club spirit with new members joining throughout the year. In June I handed the presidency of the club over to the wonderful Fernanda Escobar for the Rotary year 2019/2020

Indian food breaks all records



A new record was set in November when, for another year, Indian meals were delivered to individuals and businesses throughout Prague as part of the RCPI Indian Food Helps campaign. Gerry worked tirelessly organising volunteers, Blanka took hundreds of orders whilst Mamun and his team prepared over 800 meals. One day peaked with 166 meals prepared and deliverd!

The food is cooked by the award winning <u>Curry House Restaurant</u>. All the proceeds go towards supporting primary schooling in rural Rajasthan. We will buy equipment for the schools, school bags, exercise books and writing materials, school uniforms, hygiene kits and pay school fees for poor families. We also arrange health checks and basic treatment for children and mothers.

One lunch will enable us to buy 2 school bags or two girl's uniforms. Five lunches can pay for the school fees of one child for a year.

Collecting for an Orphanage



RCPI Members arrived before our regular meeting in cars stuffed full of household items for donation to the Orphanage in Senožaty. Despite the drizzling rain the items were

transferred by willing volunteers into two vans. All of the donations will go towards the operation of the orphanage and helping the young adults on their way as they leave the orphanage. "In trade, the volumes are greater than those traded with the Russian Federation" said Dr Irsang, emphasising that the Czech Republic is a key partner of Germany not least because of its 815km long border. Dr Israng commented that in some areas there is always room for improvement, not least in logistical matters of ambulances or snowploughs crossing the border - here we can make things more efficient.
